WHEELCHAIRS

|  | <p>STANDARD WHEELCHAIR</p> <p>A manual wheelchair can either be pushed by a caregiver or the user can propel themselves by hand using the large rear wheels.</p> |
|  | <p>TILTBACK/RECLINING WHEELCHAIR</p> <p>A manual wheelchair with a seatback that may be adjusted to many different angles and padded arm rests that may be removed or extended.</p> |
|  | <p>TILT-IN-SPACE WHEELCHAIR</p> <p>A manual wheelchair with adjustable armrests, backrest, and push-bars that both reclines and tilts to in place accommodate the particular needs of an individual.</p> |
|  | <p>TRANSPORT WHEELCHAIR</p> <p>A lightweight wheelchair that is smaller and easier to move around and maneuver through smaller spaces. It is intended to be pushed by a caregiver because the small wheels do not allow the user to propel themselves.</p> |

|  | <p>WHEELCHAIR CUSHIONS</p> <p>Soft foam or other materials provide comfort and help eliminate pressure sores.</p> |

AIDS FOR DAILY LIVING

|  | <p>DRESSING STICK</p> <p>A long wooden or plastic stick with a hook on one end that can assist in various dressing tasks such as grabbing a shirt or pants.</p> |
|  | <p>LONG HANDLE SHOE HORN</p> <p>By slipping the shoe horn behind the heel it allows an individual to slip their foot into the shoe with minimal effort.</p> |
|  | <p>REACHER</p> <p>A long plastic or metal stick with a clamp at the end that is used to pick up items when the individual is lacking range of motion, cannot bend, or reach forward.</p> |

|  | <p>SOCK AID</p> <p>Assists an individual in putting on socks by providing an open space for the foot to go through, allowing an individual to pull the sock onto the foot and over the heel in with ease.</p> |
|   | <p>BUTTON HOOK</p> <p>A handheld wand with a wire loop at the end use to pull a button through a buttonhole using only one hand. The opposite end has a hook to aid in raising and lowering zippers</p> |
|  | <p>LEG LIFTER</p> <p>A long piece of stiff fabric with a looped end used to move a leg from one area to another.</p> |
|  | <p>UTENSILS WITH BUILT-UP HANDLES</p> <p>Specialized utensils with a wider grip that allow individuals to eat more efficiently if they have trouble using their arms or hands.</p> |





WALKING AIDS

|  | <p>CANES</p> <p>Assist in ambulation and come in various styles. Canes with feet offer slightly more stability.</p> |
|  | <p>WALKER</p> <p>Offering more support than a cane, walkers add additional support to maintain balance or stability while walking.</p> |
|  | <p>UP-RIGHT WALKER</p> <p>Enables users to stand <i>upright</i> and look ahead with better support, putting less force on their arms and wrists. These tend to eliminate that hunched over posture that is typically seen with standard walkers.</p> |
|  | <p>U-STEP WALKER</p> <p>The U-Step Walker is a unique walking aid specially designed for people suffering from Parkinson's Disease and other Neurological Conditions where there is postural instability. It features Reversed braking system meaning The U-Step will not roll until you gently squeeze either hand brake and the rolling resistance of the wheels can be adjusted to provide speed control.</p> |

|  | <p>ROLLATOR</p> <p>The rollator has four wheels, handlebars, and a built-in seat, allowing the user to stop and rest when needed.</p> |
|  | <p>CRUTCHES</p> <p>Aid In ambulation by transferring body weight from the legs to the torso and arms. Mainly used to assist those with lower extremity injuries.</p> |
|  | <p>KNEE SCOOTER</p> <p>A knee scooter, also called a knee walker, is a mobility aid device with three or four wheels, a knee rest support, and a steering handle. It allows for weight to be taken off an injured leg by resting it on a padded knee support while using the uninjured foot to ride around.</p> |

|  | <p>SIT-TO-STAND LIFT</p> <p>A sit-to-stand manual lift with hydraulic pump that provides transfer support that is ideal for individuals who are partially weightbearing. Wheels and low clearance design allow for easy maneuverability around the home and under furniture.</p> |

|  | <p>HOYER LIFT – MANUAL OR ELECTRIC</p> <p>A lift used to safely move an individual from one surface to another. The manual style is operated by a handle and hydraulic pump that moves the sling-bearing arm up and down. The electric style is equipped with a motor that powers the arm movement.</p> |
|  | <p>SECURITY POLE – GRAB BAR</p> <p>A floor to ceiling pole with a pivoting curved bar used for balance and ease of sitting and standing. Easily installs via tension without extra tools.</p> |
|  | <p>EASY UP SEAT ASSIST</p> <p>A device that gives individuals a boost when going from seated to standing. No electricity needed.</p> |
|  | <p>GAIT BELT</p> <p>A safety device used to support individuals as they move and prevent falls. It also decreases a caregiver's risk of back injury while helping a person and provides a safe, stable surface to hold onto during movements.</p> |
|  | <p>TRANSFER BOARD</p> <p>A piece of equipment that helps transfer an individual from one surface to another as they slide across.</p> |

|  | <p>HOSPITAL BED – FULL AUTO</p> <p>A fully electric hospital bed that easily allows for adjustments to the head and foot of bed as well as the height of the frame with the push of a button.</p> |
|  | <p>HOSPITAL BED – SEMI AUTO</p> <p>A Semi-Auto hospital bed that easily allows for adjustments to the head and foot of bed with the push of a button. To raise and lower the height of the bed a crank is used.</p> |
|  | <p>HOSPITAL BED MATTRESS</p> <p>Standard hospital bed mattresses tend to be innerspring or foam</p> |
|  | <p>AIR MATTRESS SYSTEM</p> <p>A mattress with air cells and sensors that ensure weight is well distributed for maximum comfort and prevention of pressure injuries.</p> |
|  | <p>ALTERNATING PRESSURE MATTRESS Topper</p> <p>An inflatable mattress topper with a quiet pump that automatically provides variable waves of pressure to prevent pressure injuries.</p> |

|  | <p>BED RAILS</p> <p>Come in a variety of shapes and sizes they are installed on a bed to prevent an individual from falling out or to grasp onto for repositioning.</p> |
|  | <p>BED TRAPEZE</p> <p>Attaches to the bed to function as a grab bar, providing leverage for individuals so they can position themselves without help.</p> |
|  | <p>HOSPITAL BEDSIDE TABLE</p> <p>An adjustable, wheeled table that can easily be moved around and over the bed.</p> |
|  | <p>FOOT TENT – BLANKET SUPPORT</p> <p>A structure that attaches to the end of the bed to prevent blankets from creating too much pressure on an individual's foot and allowing air flow for the foot. Commonly used for individuals with sensory issues or injuries to the area.</p> |
|  | <p>HEEL PROTECTOR</p> <p>Used by individuals who spend most of their time lying down to relieve pressure, prevent twisting of the leg, and avoid friction to prevent pressure ulcers.</p> |
|  | <p>POSITIONING WEDGE</p> <p>A sturdy foam wedge used for support and stabilization that is useful when repositioning an individual to prevent pressure injury.</p> |

|  | <p>BEDSIDE COMMUNE</p> <p>Adult chair used for toileting that is made of a frame equipped with a toilet seat and a removable bucket.</p> |
|  | <p>BEDSIDE COMMUNE - DROP ARM</p> <p>A bedside commode with easy-release drop arms for more convenient side transfer in tight spaces.</p> |
|  | <p>TOILET SAFETY RAILS</p> <p>A frame that attaches to the toilet to provide support while sitting down and getting up. Height is adjustable to accommodate for a raised toilet seat.</p> |
|  | <p>RAISED TOILET SEAT</p> <p>Allows individuals to sit up higher while using the toilet and makes it easier for them to return to standing when they are finished.</p> |
|  | <p>BEDPAN</p> <p>A receptacle used for toileting of bed-bound individuals. Easy to clean and allows for relief without having to leave the bed.</p> |
|  | <p>URINAL - HANDHELD</p> <p>A portable container for males to use while traveling or unable to get up to use the facilities to urinate.</p> |

|  | <p>BRIEFS WITH TABS</p> <p>Offers protection for incontinence and can easily be taken on and off utilizing tabs.</p> |
|  | <p>ADULT PULL-ON UNDERWEAR</p> <p>Disposable adult underwear that offers protection for incontinence.</p> |
|  | <p>INCONTINENCE PADS</p> <p>A pad for men or women placed in the underwear that offers protection for incontinence throughout the day.</p> |
|  | <p>BED PADS</p> <p>Disposable, absorbent barrier that prevents linens from getting soiled.</p> |
|  | <p>WASHABLE BED PADS</p> <p>Washable absorbent barrier that prevents linens from getting soiled.</p> |
|  | <p>HOSPITAL GOWN</p> <p>Short, collarless gown that ties in the back which allows for easy application and removal of clothing</p> |

|  | <p>HOSPITAL SOCKS</p> <p>A sock with non-slip tread on the bottom that helps prevent falls and a non-constrictive top that won't be tight around the leg.</p> |
|  | <p>COMPRESSION SOCKS</p> <p>A special type of hosiery made to help in the prevention of swelling and venous clotting in the lower legs. Various heights are available including below knee or above knee.</p> |
|  | <p>WIPES</p> <p>Moistened wipes used to quickly clean an individual's skin and sensitive areas.</p> |
|  | <p>BATH WIPES</p> <p>Single-use, moistened clothes that cleanse and moisturize skin without any need for rinsing. Useful for individuals who are unable to bathe.</p> |
|  | <p>SKIN CREAM PROTECTANTS</p> <p>Used to prevent and treat rashes, burns, scrapes, and many other skin irritations by forming a protective layer on the skin.</p> |

BATHING ACCESSORIES

|  | <p>SHOWER CHAIR</p> <p>A chair with rubberized feet and a durable, plastic seat for use in the shower or bath. Available with or without a back. Some may also have arms.</p> |
|  | <p>TUB TRANSFER BENCH</p> <p>An extra-long shower bench that is placed over the tub wall, allowing an individual to sit down in the chair while outside of the tub and then slide across the chair to transfer into the tub.</p> |
|  | <p>SLIDING TRANSFER BENCH</p> <p>An extra-long shower bench that is placed over the tub wall, allowing an individual to sit down in the chair while outside of the tub. The seat then slides the individual over into the tub.</p> |
|  | <p>ROLLING SHOWER CHAIR</p> <p>A rolling shower chair for easy access to bathing. It can be rolled out of the bathroom without the need to transfer the person on a wet surface.</p> |
|  | <p>TUB SAFETY RAIL</p> <p>A rail that clamps onto the edge of the bathtub and is securely tightened to help while transferring into and out of the tub.</p> |
|  | <p>SHAMPOO BASIN - INFLATABLE</p> <p>Allows for portable, in-bed shampoo washing and cleansing.</p> |

|  | <p>SHAMPOO TRAY</p> <p>Provides a way for comfortable hair washing from a seated position with assistance from a caregiver. Stability straps may be available with some items.</p> |

|  | <p>GERI CHAIR</p> <p>A large, padded reclining chair with wheels designed to allow patients recovering from illness and surgery to get out of bed and sit comfortably.</p> |
|  | <p>BED TRAY</p> <p>A tray with foldable legs that fits over a person's lap and functions as a small and easily portable table.</p> |
|  | <p>LIFT CHAIR - RECLINER</p> <p>Assists individuals getting up from a seated position as well as functions as a recliner.</p> |

|  | <p>LAUNDRY CART</p> <p>A metal cart on wheels that can be used for transporting laundry, groceries, or other heavy loads. Is collapsible for easy storage.</p> |
|  | <p>BEDSIDE STEP UP/STEP STOOLS</p> <p>Bedside step up makes getting into bed safer.</p> <p>Step stools used for accessing out of reach objects.</p> |

|  | <p>MOTORIZED SCOOTERS</p> <p>Smaller and more lightweight scooters for easier transportation.</p> |
|  | <p>POWER WHEELCHAIRS</p> <p>Power chairs typically have more features available to assist with client's specific needs. They are more robust and can maneuver over more difficult terrain.</p> |

|  | <p>OXYGEN CONCENTRATORS Floor and Portable styles provide concentrated oxygen for individuals requiring it.</p> |

|  | <p>NEBULIZER MACHINE A machine that turns liquid medication into a mist so that it may be easily breathed into the user's lungs through a mask or mouthpiece.</p> |

|  | <p>WOUND CARE Assorted Wound care supplies, gauze wrap and pads, cling, tape, ace bandages, etc.</p> |

|  | <p>POLAR CARE CUBE</p> <p>A cold therapy system used to reduce pain and swelling in the shoulder or knee. A cooler is filled with ice and water that flows through a slim tubing system to be spread out around the targeted area</p> |
|  | <p>WALKING BOOT</p> <p>A boot that restricts movement in the lower leg and ankle to facilitate healing after an injury or surgery. It may be worn after surgery to reduce risk of reinjury.</p> |
|  | <p>MISCELANEOUS BRACES/SLINGS</p> |
